



Night work on Alfords Point Road, Alfords Point from Monday 4 September

The NSW Government is funding this \$40 million project to improve safety and traffic flow on Alfords Point Road between Georges River and Brushwood Drive.

As part of this work we will remove the existing road surface and install a new layer of asphalt on the northbound lanes.

To minimise impact to road users, this work will be carried out at night. There will be up to **20 shifts** of night work from **Monday 4 September** to **Tuesday 31 October**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **7pm** and **5am**.

Day time work will also continue. Our day time working hours are between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures on Alfords Point Road between Georges River Bridge and Brushwood Drive to remove the existing road surface and install new asphalt efficiently and ensure the safety of road users and workers.

The on-ramp onto Brushwood Drive will be closed during the night work, with a detour in place. Access through to Menai will be maintained under traffic control.

We have provided a map to show the location of the work and the Brushwood Drive on-ramp detour.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?


