

## Out of hours work on Alfords Point Road, Alfords Point during February

### The NSW Government is funding this \$40 million project to improve safety and traffic flow on Alfords Point Road between Georges River and Brushwood Drive.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing with construction work on this important project. As part of this work we will be paving asphalt and installing line marking on the Brushwood Drive on ramp and the northbound lanes of Alfords Point Road. This work will be carried out at night to minimise impact to motorists.

The work will take up to **eight shifts of night work** to be completed before **Monday 20 February**, weather permitting. There will be some lane closures and detours during this time. Our working hours will be from 7pm to 5am.

We have provided a map to show the location of the work and the detour.

#### How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and lights associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations across this period. Every effort will also be made to focus lights only on the working area, however there may be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

There will be a lane closure and a detour in place to ensure safe access in and out of the site. Traffic controllers and signs will be in place.

#### Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures northbound between Brushwood Drive and Georges River. The on ramp onto Brushwood drive will be closed with a detour in place during the night work; however there will be access through to Menai. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. 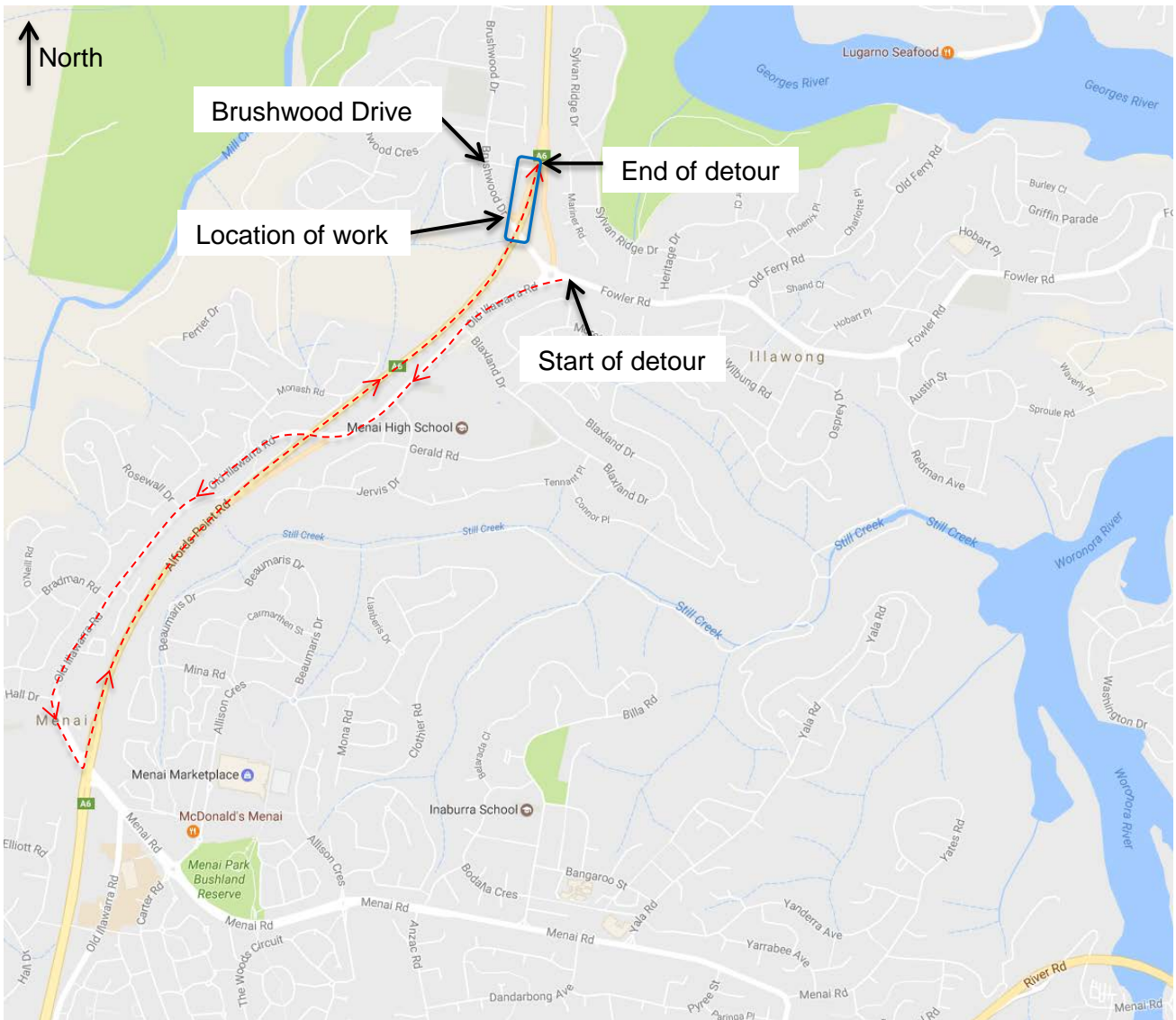
