



Night work on Alfords Point Road, Alfords Point, during February and March

The NSW Government is funding this \$40 million project to improve safety and traffic flow on Alfords Point Road between Georges River and Brushwood Drive.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing with construction work on this important project. As part of this work we will be carrying out **two sets** of **night work** for asphalting paving and line marking on the Brushwood Drive on ramp and northbound lanes, and tree clearing along the northbound lanes near Georges River. We have provided a map to show the location of the work.

Asphalt paving and line marking on Brushwood Drive and northbound lanes

The work will take up to 11 shifts of night work to complete between Monday 27 February to Saturday 25 March, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from 7pm to 5am.

Tree clearing and asphalting on northbound shoulder

We will be carrying out tree clearing along the northbound lanes of Alfords Point Road and some asphalting. As part of the work, we will be changing the traffic arrangements on the northbound lanes of Alfords Point Road from **27 February**, weather permitting. Northbound traffic will be moved 3.2 metres towards the central reserve, with two lanes continuing in operation. Southbound traffic will continue to use the existing lanes as construction progresses.

The work will take up to six shifts of night work to complete between **Monday 27 February** to **Saturday 11 March**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7pm** to **5am**.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations across this period. Every effort will also be made to focus lighting only on the working area; however there may be some spill-over of lighting into some nearby residences.

There will be a minor traffic change, a lane close and a detour in place as safe access is required in and out of the site. Traffic controllers and signs will be in place.

Traffic changes

There will be lane closures northbound from Brushwood Drive to Georges River Bridge and the Brushwood Drive on ramp onto Alfords Point Road will be closed with a detour in place during the night work, however there will be access through to Menai. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
