



Amherst Street Noise Wall

Site investigations - Amherst Street off ramp, Cammeray

The Amherst Street Noise Wall will help reduce traffic noise for nearby residents on Jenkins Street, Cammeray.

Following community feedback in 2018, we are continuing our plans to build the Amherst Street Noise Wall to help reduce noise in your area. As part of our planning we will be carrying out site investigation work from Monday 2 September.

What are site investigations?

We need to complete site investigation work to inform our detailed design and ensure we can build it safely and as quickly as possible to reduce impacts to residents. They will involve:

Utility investigations - to help us confirm the location of services such as power and telecommunications cables.

Geotechnical testing - to gather information about underground rock and soil conditions. This will involve drilling small holes about the diameter of an orange to a depth of around six to eight metres with a track mounted drilling rig.

Topographical surveys - to help inform us about the level of the land and is integral in designing the noise wall. You will see people from our team out surveying the area over the duration of the investigations.

When the work is complete, the investigation area will be restored to its previous condition.

These investigations will take place in the grassed area of the Amherst Street off ramp, Cammeray. We've included a map over the page to show the location of the work.



Our work schedule

Our work schedule will be carried out between Monday 2 September and Sunday 15 September, weather permitting. Our work hours will be:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and,
- 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

No work will be carried out on Sundays.

How will our work affect you?

Our work may involve some noisy activities. We will help to reduce noise by using noise screens where appropriate and turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

There may be some temporary traffic changes at times to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits, and follow signs and directions from our traffic controllers.
