





| TEXT 1   | <p>RED GUM STATUE RIVER WALK</p> <p>The Koondrook Barham Red Gum Statue River Walk was an initiative of the local redgum industry, starting in November 2002 with the carving of Alexander "Sandy" Arbutnot.</p> <p>Kevin Gilders, a world renowned chainsaw carver from Melbourne, produced most of the sculptures in the Walk.</p> <p>The carvings depict wildlife and local people who are significant to the region.
