



Work continues on pedestrian bridge over Beecroft Road from Saturday 16 January

The NSW Government is funding this \$5 million project to provide safer access for school students and pedestrians crossing Beecroft Road near Beecroft Public School.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing to deliver this project, which includes:

- Excavation in the Village Green and Beecroft Public School grounds including vegetation and tree removal
- Building lift shafts and concrete stairs in the Village Green and school grounds
- Lifting the bridge span into place onto the lift shafts
- Removal of the existing pedestrian crossing on the southern side of the intersection of Beecroft Road and Copeland Road
- Installing a new pedestrian fence on the eastern side of Beecroft Road
- Installing new kerbs on Beecroft Road
- Utility adjustments and relocations in the Village Green and school grounds, including installing CCTV cameras and lighting on the new bridge
- · Landscaping.

Work completed so far includes tree removal and some utility adjustments. The next stage will involve excavation and foundation work, establishing a site office and starting work on the concrete lift shafts and stairs.

Day work will continue from **Saturday 16 January.** Our working hours will be from **7am to 6pm** between **Mondays and Fridays** and from **7am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**. No day work will be carried out on **Sundays**.

We will carry out up to 12 shifts of night work between Sunday 17 January and Thursday 17 March, excluding Saturdays. Our working hours will be from 8pm to 5am. Further night work will be required to complete the project and residents and businesses will be notified before night work starts.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work but we will make every effort to minimise impacts by completing the noisiest work by 11pm.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
