

## Changed traffic conditions on the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry from Monday 11 October

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

### What are we doing?

We will be laying the final layer of asphalt on the southbound and northbound carriageways of the Princes Highway between Mullers Lane, Berry and Cambewarra Road/Moss Vale Road, Bomaderry from **Monday 11 October to late December**, weather permitting.

Work will be carried out from **Monday to Saturday between 7am and 6pm**.

### How will the work affect you?

Work will take place over three months starting from the northern end of the project. Nearby residents will be informed as work progresses to each location. A map showing the staging of this work is provided over the page.

There will be temporary traffic changes in place with sections of traffic moved onto the opposite carriageway while asphalt is laid to facilitate plant movements and asphalt delivery. Access in and out of local roads may also be restricted and detours will be place. We will notify residents in advance of any changes to access.
