Changed traffic conditions on the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry until early 2022

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

The final layer of asphalt will continue to be laid, including line marking, on the southbound and northbound carriageways of the Princes Highway between Mullers Lane, Berry and Cambewarra Road/Moss Vale Road, Bomaderry until late February 2022, weather permitting.

Work will continue to be carried out during the day between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Saturday and at night between 6pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday. There will be no more than two consecutive nights of work in the same location.

We will be taking a break over Christmas from Friday 24 December 2021 until Sunday 9 January 2022.

How will the work affect you?

Final asphalt work started in October and has been progressing from the northern end of the project. However, recent wet weather conditions has delayed this work. Nearby residents will continue to be informed as work progresses to each location. A map showing the remaining asphalt to be completed is provided over the page.

There will be temporary traffic changes in place with sections of traffic moved onto the opposite carriageway while asphalt is laid. Access in and out of local roads may also be restricted with possible detours in place. We will notify residents in advance of any changes to access.
