

Changed traffic conditions on Princes Highway between Turners Lane, Jaspers Brush and Bomaderry roundabout.

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be moving southbound traffic onto the new southbound carriageway between Turners Lane and the Moss Vale/Cambewarra Road roundabout at Bomaderry from **Friday 17 September**.

To enable these changes we will be carrying out night work from **Sunday 12 September**, weather permitting. Work will involve road resurfacing, line making and barrier relocation and will take place at night between **6pm and 5am** to minimise the impact to motorists.

Work will be for up to two nights at each location. Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs and on the project website.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and light associated with this night work. Work will include the use of lighting towers, cranes, road surfacing machinery and heavy vehicles.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be lane closures, stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place.

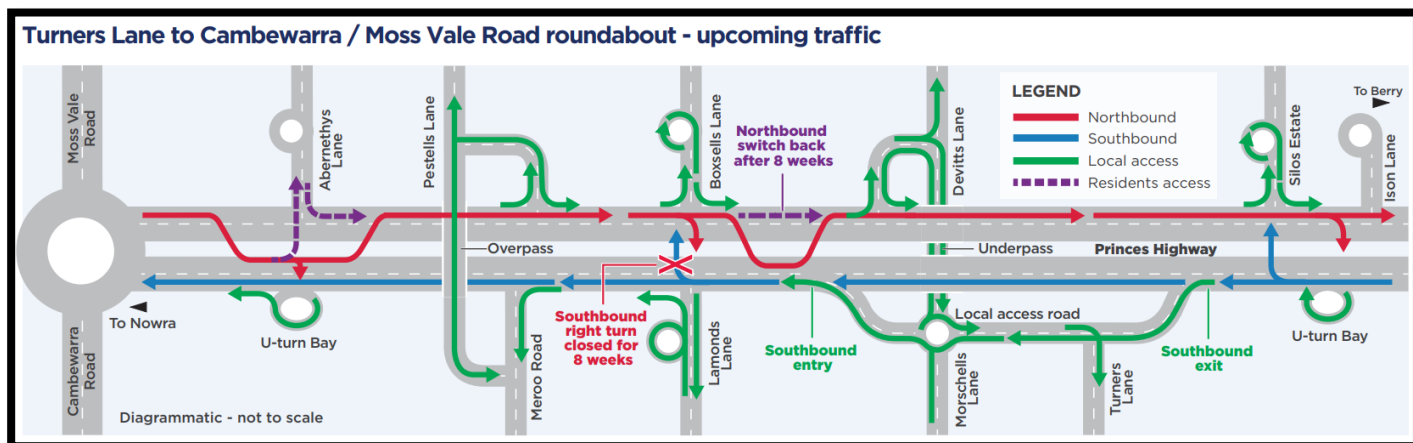
Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

Southbound carriageway

From **Friday 17 September** southbound motorists will use the new southbound carriageway between Turners Lane and the Moss Vale/Cambewarra Road Bomaderry roundabout. Access to local roads including Turners Lane, Devitts Lane and Morschels Lane will be via the Turners Lane offload ramp.

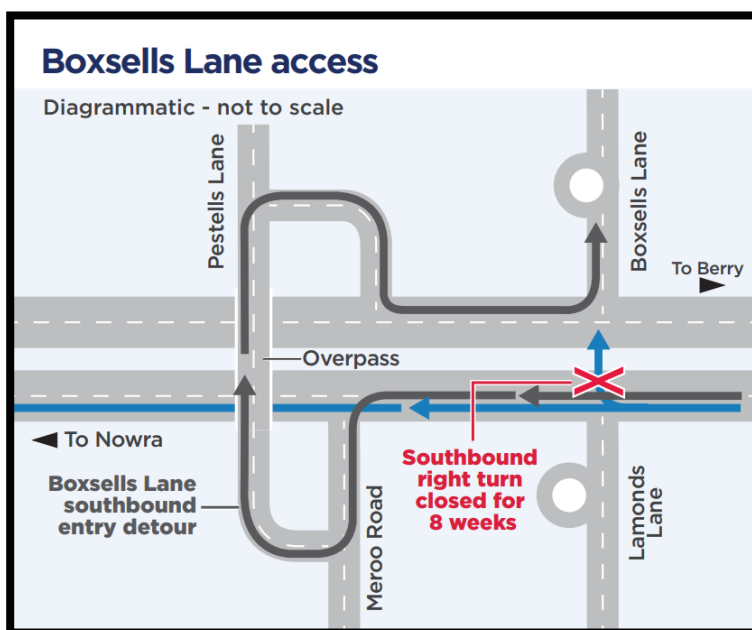
Some additional work on the northbound lanes near Abernethys Lane and between Boxsells and Devitts Lane will be required. During this work northbound traffic at these locations will temporarily switch onto the southbound side for eight weeks. Resident access will be maintained.



Boxsells Lane access

From **Friday 17 September 2021** right turn access to Boxsells Lane will temporarily be restricted for up to eight weeks while we complete works in the intersection.

During this time, southbound traffic wishing to turn right into Boxsells Lane will need to travel further south to the Meroo Road/Pestells Lane interchange before using the new overpass and travelling north along the Princes Highway to Boxsells Lane.
