

Night Works on Princes Highway between Silos Estate and Turners Lane, Jaspers Brush.

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be relocating concrete barriers and constructing concrete kerb and medians on the Princes Highway between Silos Estate and Turners Lane. Works are planned to be carried out at night during the week starting **Sunday 5 September 2021** (weather permitting). There will be no more than two nights of work in any single location.

Work will be carried out between **6pm** and **5am** to minimise the impact to motorists.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs and on the project website.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and light associated with this work. Work will include the use of lighting towers, cranes, concrete kerb machine and construction vehicles. This kerb construction will reduce the shoulder width through the area and require southbound traffic wanting to enter Silos Estate to detour via Devitts Lane roundabout to return north.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be lane closures, stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control. Transport for NSW thanks motorists for their patience during this time.
