

## Night work on Princes Highway at Strongs Road, Jaspers Brush from Tuesday 2 February

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

### What are we doing?

We will be installing temporary work platforms and pre-cast panels on the new Strongs Road overpass, as well as installing retaining wall panels on **Tuesday 2 February** for up to two nights (weather permitting).

Work will be carried out between **6pm** and **7am** to minimise the impact to motorists.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs.

A map of the work areas is provided over the page.

### How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and light associated with this work however we will make every effort to minimise disruption to residents with noisier work to be completed by midnight where possible.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
