

Rescheduled night work on the Princes Highway between Strongs Road and Jaspers Brush Road

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

Due to recent weather conditions, planned concrete kerb and median work along the Princes Highway between Strongs Road and Jaspers Brush Creek has been rescheduled and will now take place from **Monday 21 February to Friday 25 February**, weather permitting.

Work will take place at **night** between **6pm** and **5am** and there will be no more than two consecutive nights of work carried out.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs along the highway and on the project website.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and light associated with this work. Work will include the use of lighting towers, concrete trucks, concrete kerb machinery, crane trucks and construction vehicles.

A map showing temporary traffic arrangements while this work is carried out is provided over the page.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be traffic changes, detours, lane closures, stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
