

## Traffic changes for Strongs Road, Jaspers Brush.

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

### What are we doing?

From **Monday 1 November**, weather permitting the newly constructed section of Strongs Road will open to northbound motorists. Work will continue to be carried out to build the new roundabout at Strongs Road and some temporary traffic changes will be in place to safely carry out this work.

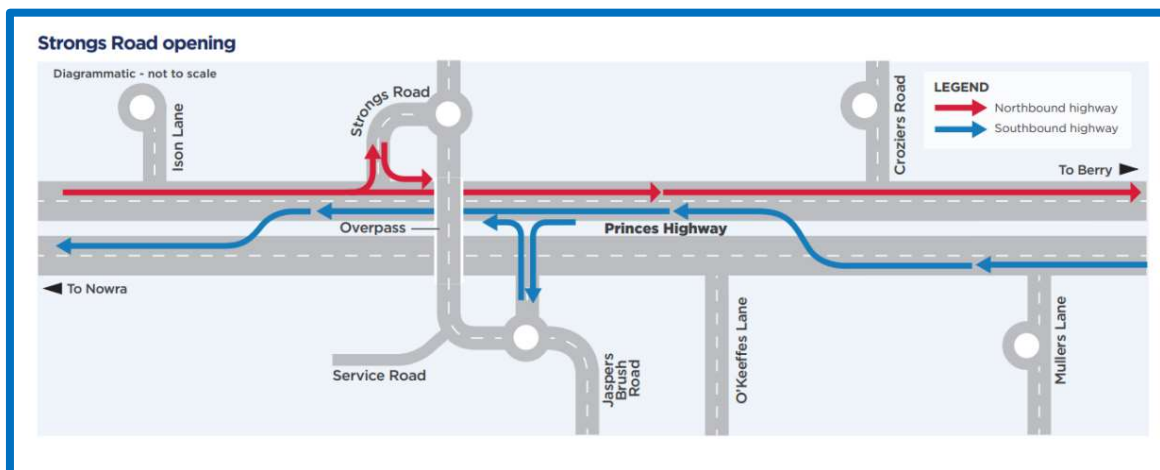
### How will it affect you?

Northbound motorists will be able to turn left into Strongs Road from the highway and will no longer need to turn right at Jaspers Brush Road. Residents of Strongs Road, Jaspers Brush Road and connecting roads will also use the new section to directly access the highway and travel north. This removes the need to travel south to Ison Lane to turn around. A map of the change is provided below.

Southbound highway motorists will continue to use Jaspers Brush Road and the overpass to access Strongs Road.

There may be some short traffic stoppages during construction and we will make every effort to minimise disruption during this work. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of signs and traffic controller.
