

## Urgent Night work on the Princes Highway at Jaspers Brush on Wednesday 15 January

### What are we doing?

Urgent work is required to repair a small section of asphalt along the Princes Highway between Croziers Road and O'Keeffes Lane, Jaspers Brush. This repair is required prior to this weeks expected rainfall to prevent further degradation of the road surface.

The work will be carried out on the **night of Wednesday 15 January 2020**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be between **7pm** and **5am** to minimise impact to motorists on the Princes Highway.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work and will involve the use of bobcats, trucks, road sweepers, lighting towers, and a drum roller.

### Traffic changes

Traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
