

Completed and upcoming improvement work on Big River Way from September to December 2022

The NSW Government is funding essential road work on Big River Way to provide a safer, longer lasting road.

Transport for NSW is continuing improvement work on Big River Way from September to December 2022.

Work hours

Work will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm and 7am to 1pm Saturday.

Work at Lees drain will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 6am and 6pm and 8am to 2pm on Saturday.

Impacted residents will be notified if work outside these hours is required.

How will the work affect you?

Work will involve the use of machinery, which generate noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use, positioning machinery away from residences and where possible starting noisy activities later in the morning.

Access to properties will be maintained. If this should change, affected residents will be notified.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of road users and workers.

Traffic control and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place intermittently at work locations from September for the duration of the work.

During work hours, a single lane alternate traffic flow arrangement may be implemented. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time while this traffic control is in place.
