



Project update - Intersection improvements on Bigge Street and the Hume Highway, Warwick Farm

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$246 million Pinch Point Program which aims to reduce congestion, improve traffic flow and improve travel times on Sydney's main roads, particularly during weekday peak periods.

Roads and Maritime is upgrading the intersection of Bigge Street and the Hume Highway. The project includes:

- Providing a dedicated left turn lane on the Hume Highway into Bigge Street. This will improve traffic flow along the Hume Highway and improve safety by reducing the risk of rear end crashes
- Providing an additional lane on Bigge Street, so that there is a dedicated left turn lane and two
 dedicated right turn lanes, which will reduce queuing and waiting times for vehicles turning onto
 the Hume Highway.

Construction work was scheduled to start in August 2016 but was delayed, stage one started on **Monday 12 September.** Up to **10 night shifts** are planned between **Wednesday 21 September** and **Monday 7 November**, excluding **Saturdays**, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be from **8pm** to **5am**. We will also be working during the day until late 2017 from **7am** to **6pm** excluding **Sundays** and **public holidays**.

We have included a map to help explain the project.

Undisturbed asbestos has been identified at this site. We are implementing an asbestos management plan that details safe work practices and will ensure the asbestos removal is managed to strict Environmental Protection Authority requirements. The asbestos removal will be managed to ensure there is no risk to the public.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the noisiest work before **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.
