

Birchgrove Wharf Upgrade

Wharf reopening on Tuesday 24 April

The new Birchgrove Wharf will open on Tuesday 24 April.

The wharf has been upgraded as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure across the state. The upgrades to Birchgrove Wharf will help improve safety, accessibility and comfort for customers and make boarding and disembarking quicker and easier.

F8 Cockatoo River ferry services will resume from 6:30am on Tuesday 24 April from the upgraded wharf.
