The wharf upgrade will provide:

- ▶ better protection from the wind, rain and sun
- ▶ improved seating and waiting areas
- ▶ improved safety for customers
- ▶ quicker and more efficient ferry boarding and disembarking.
- ▶ effective wayfinding signage and lighting.

The Review of Environmental Factors has been produced and will be displayed for community feedback from **Monday 21 August to Monday 11 September 2017**.

The Review of Environmental Factors outlines details of the proposed upgrade, potential project impacts and how these will be managed. The document also incorporates feedback from the community heard during consultation.
