The NSW Government is upgrading Birchgrove Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program.

Planning for the new wharf is currently underway and as part of the planning process we would like to hear your feedback on the proposed concept.

This feedback will be included in the Review of Environmental Factors. This document will be publicly displayed for further feedback before the start of work is finalised.

The NSW Government is progressively upgrading ferry wharves throughout Sydney Harbour to improve Sydney's ferry service for passengers. The new wharf is being delivered as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure.

The upgraded wharf would provide:

- ▶ Better protection from the wind, rain and sun
- ▶ Improved seating and waiting areas
- ▶ Improved safety for customers
- ▶ Quicker and more efficient ferry boarding and disembarking
- ▶ Effective wayfinding signage and lighting.
