Night work and major traffic changes on Bringelly Road from Kelly Street to Glen Allan Road, Rossmore from Monday, 20 August 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are funding this work under the \$509 million Bringelly Road Upgrade between Camden Valley Way, Leppington and The Northern Road, Bringelly. This project is part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan.

Roads and Maritime Services is working to upgrade Bringelly Road. As part of this work, traffic will be switched to a new temporary ramp further east to connect a portion of the newly built westbound lanes between King Street and Glen Allan Road, Rossmore.

Our work schedule

In preparation to open the new carriageways on Bringelly Road from King Street to Glen Allan Road, a temporary ramp will be constructed. Work will be carried out over one night when traffic volumes are lower between **7pm** and **6am** on **Monday 20 August 2018**, weather permitting. Work includes asphaltting, barrier movement and line marking. Traffic will travel on the new temporary ramp from **Tuesday 21 August 2018**, weather permitting.

The no right turn ban at the intersection of Bringelly Road and Glen Allan Road will continue. Due to safety concerns a no right turn from Bringelly Road to Kelly Street will be in place from **6am Monday 20 August 2018**, weather permitting. The no right turn will be active **Monday** to **Friday** between **6am** to **10am** and **3pm** to **7pm**.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this night work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. Resident and pedestrian access will be maintained. Please see map over the page for more detail on the location of the work.

Traffic changes

A detour via Fourth Avenue and Tenth Avenue for heavy vehicles and Fourth Avenue and Sixth Avenue for light vehicles will be in place during the no right turn ban at Kelly Street. Electronic message signs will be in place to advise road users of changes.

A map has been included to help show the upcoming changes.
