Night work at the intersection of Camden Valley Way, Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road, Leppington from Friday 1 June 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are funding this work under the \$509 million Bringelly Road upgrade between Camden Valley Way, Leppington and The Northern Road, Bringelly. This project is part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan.

As part of this work, Roads and Maritime Services will carry out upgrades to the storm water service at the intersection of Camden Valley Way, Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road, Leppington.

Work includes excavation, pipe laying, back filling and asphaltting. To minimise the impact on motorists, this work will take place between **7pm and 9am**, weather permitting, on:

- **Friday 1 and Saturday 2 June 2018**
- **Friday 15 and Saturday 16 June 2018**
- **Friday 22 and Saturday 23 June 2018.**

We have included a map to help show the location of the work.

Traffic changes

All approaches to the intersection of Camden Valley Way, Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road, Leppington will be reduced to one lane during the work.

Camden Valley Way southbound will be closed from the intersection of Camden Valley Way, Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road, Leppington for about 50 metres; a detour will be in place via Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road south, Leppington.

Electronic message signs will be in place to advise road users of changes.

There may be some short delays at the intersection as traffic controllers help trucks to safely enter and exit the construction site.

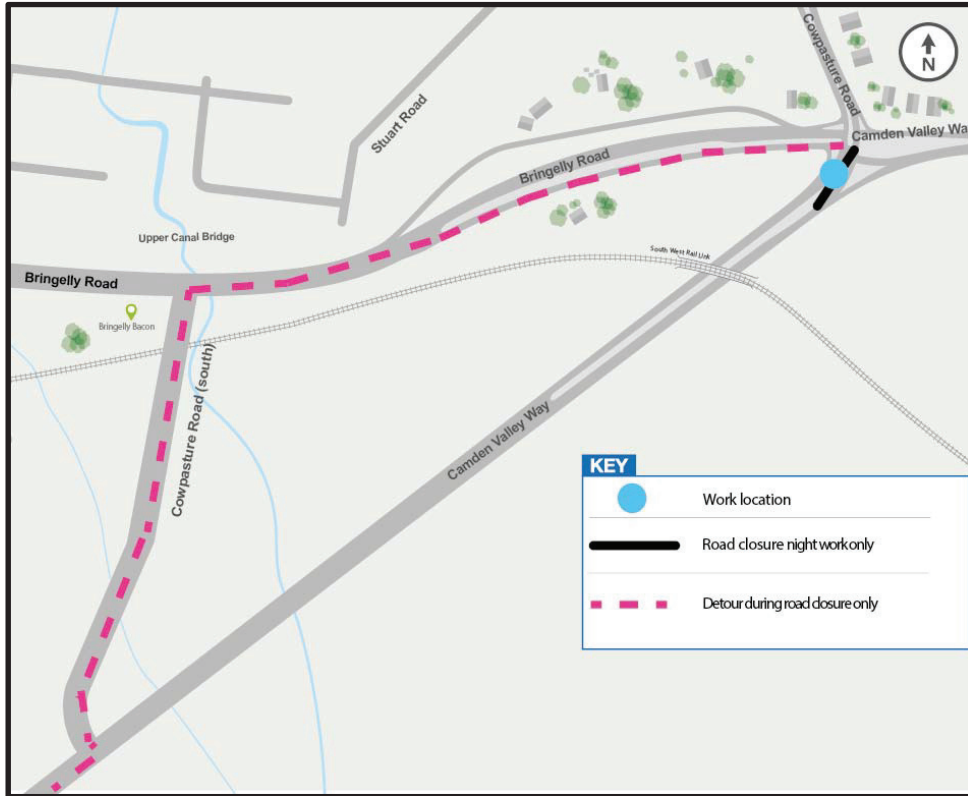
