## **Out of hours work on Bringelly Road between North Avenue and Glen Allen Road, Rossmore on Saturday 7 July 2018**

**The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan.**

As part of The Northern Road and Bringelly Road upgrades, Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out electrical relocation work on Bringelly Road.

Work will include removing existing power poles and wires and replacing them with new ones. To complete the work safely and to minimise the impact on road users, work will be take place on **Saturday 7 July 2018** between **8am** and **5pm**, weather permitting.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

### **How will the work affect you?**

Our work may be noisy at times, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses.

### **Traffic changes**

Temporary traffic changes and lane closures will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures may affect travel times.

Motorists are asked to observe traffic controls and signage when travelling through work areas.
