# Burrill Lake Bridge project – Temporary closure of Dolphin Point Road at the Princes Highway from late March 2016

# The NSW Government is funding this \$58 million project to replace the bridge over Burrill Lake.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted BGC Contracting Pty Ltd to deliver the Burrill Lake Bridge project. Early construction work started in late February 2016 including building the project site office in Lions Park, utility service relocations and ground clearing work.

The northern end of Dolphin Point Road will be the location for a site compound and work area. Dolphin Point Road at the Princes Highway will be temporarily closed to local traffic from **late March 2016 until early 2017**, weather permitting. This will allow for the safety of motorists and workers during construction of the project.

## How will the work affect you?

During the closure access to and from Dolphin Point Road will be via the roundabout at Wallaroy Drive and the Princes Highway. A temporary cul-de-sac will be built in Dolphin Point Road to allow vehicles accessing Lions Park to safely turn around. We have included a map to help explain the closure.

Construction vehicles and machinery will continue to access Dolphin Point Road to travel between the site office and stockpile areas. Pedestrians will still be able to access Lions Park and any changes will be marked by signs and barriers.

### **Traffic changes**

During construction there will other temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs and keep to roadwork speed limits.
