Investigation work will be carried out at Burrill Lake on the Princes Highway from Monday 23 February 2015

The NSW Government is funding \$3 million to develop a design for the replacement of Burrill Lake Bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out investigation work including works to determine the depth of rock in the lake and soil characteristics.

Work will be carried out between **23 and 25 February 2015, between 7am and 6pm**, weather permitting.

Changed traffic conditions

One lane of traffic may be closed while the work is carried out. Motorists will be able to pass through the worksite under the guidance of traffic controllers.

Road users are asked to adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. Motorists may experience delays of up to 2 minutes due to these changed traffic conditions.

We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.

Up to date information, including any date changes and detours will be displayed on electronic message signs along the road.
