


Night work on North West T-way to relocate electrical services on 3 December

November 2022

The NSW Government is funding a new bus layover facility at Blacktown as part of the Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, which aims to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion for all road users.

What are we doing?

Work will involve relocation of Endeavour Energy electrical services on the footpath next to Sackville T-way station.

Our work schedule

Night work will take place on **Saturday 3 December 2022 from 6am to 6pm**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Properties which may have their power service affected due to the works will be notified directly by Endeavour Energy at least 10 days prior to the works.

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance where possible, including turning off equipment when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be a temporary lane closure on the T-Way to ensure the work zone is safe. However, bus services will remain unaffected. Access for residents, pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles will be always maintained on the T-Way and Gordon Street. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
