Dear householder/business operator,

Re: Traffic changes on Narellan Road, near the Hume Highway Interchange at Campbelltown – starting Monday 20 August 2012

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is going to construct a third lane westbound, on Narellan Road between the Hume Highway interchange and The Australian Botanic Gardens entrance at Mount Annan.

The speed limit will be **reduced from 80km/h to 60km/h westbound** on Narellan Road between Blaxland Road and Mount Annan Drive, as a result.

The new westbound lane is for vehicles exiting the south bound loop off-load ramp at the Hume Highway interchange. This will improve road safety and improve traffic flow during the afternoon peak time for motorists exiting the Hume Highway.

Changes will start on Monday 20 August 2012, weather permitting. Traffic light adjustments, new signs and line marking will be installed **during the night between Sunday and Friday from 8pm to 5am** over three weeks. There will be some lane closures to ensure road worker safety during these hours – traffic can still travel in both directions.

The reduction to 60km/h is an interim measure before a future upgrade of Narellan Road. This upgrade is now being planned and would ease traffic congestion in Sydney's rapidly expanding South West region. The interim speed zone changes will remain in force until construction is funded and ready to begin.

This work is in conjunction with current maintenance work to provide extra lanes from Hartley Road to Mount Annan Drive and to repair the road surface. This essential maintenance work is scheduled to be completed in late August 2012, weather permitting.

Residents will be notified of future night work when schedules are confirmed.

Motorists are asked to follow the signs, reduce your speed and follow the directions of traffic controllers. Minor traffic delays may occur.

RMS apologises for any inconvenience this work may cause, but every effort will be made to minimise traffic and noise impacts.
