Dear resident/business operator,

**Re: Road work on Narellan Road, near Mount Annan Christian College  
Work to remove 40 km/h school zone – starting Wednesday 3 October 2012**

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is planning road work on **Narellan Road** between **Tramway Drive/Mount Annan Drive and 150 metres west of the school access road** at Mount Annan to **remove school zone signs and line marking**. In conjunction with this work, we are also making changes to the local access road to Mount Annan Christian College to improve safety while allowing buses to access the school. This work is all planned to be completed by the end of school holidays, weather permitting.

**Work to remove the school zone** is scheduled to start on **Wednesday 3 October 2012 and continue** until **Friday 5 October 2012**, weather permitting. **Work will be done at night from 8pm to 5am between Sundays and Fridays** to minimise traffic impacts, and there will be partial lane closures during these general working hours to create a safe working area. Approximately **2 night shifts** are required during this time.

**To facilitate the school zone removal**, during early October, RMS is making changes to the Mount Annan Christian College local access road involving:

- Localised widening to the bend in Mount Annan Church Road to allow buses and cars to safely negotiate the bend.
- Changes to the traffic signal timing to minimise delays for drivers exiting the school on to Narellan Road.
- New traffic management arrangements to safely allow bus access to and from the school. This will give priority for vehicles entering the school. Vehicles exiting the school will be required to give way to vehicles entering.

There will be noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of noise on residents.

During this work please follow the signs, including reduced speed limits, and follow the direction of traffic controllers. Some delays are expected due to the changed traffic conditions. **Keep up-to-date** on any changes by checking **[www.livetraffic.com](http://www.livetraffic.com)**.
