Field investigations, Camden Valley Way to Brooks Road – Campbelltown Road upgrade

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out preparatory work from Wednesday 27 August for site investigations that will inform the detailed design for the Campbelltown Road upgrade.

Roads and Maritime has started work on the detailed design for the 5.4 kilometre future upgrade of Campbelltown Road, between Camden Valley Way, Casula and Brooks Road, Denham Court.

To progress this design work, Roads and Maritime needs to inspect existing utilities, including power, telecommunications, gas and water and take geotechnical samples along Campbelltown Road between Camden Valley Way and Brooks Road.

In preparation for these inspections, **survey work** will be done that includes:

- Ground marking with spray paint
- Lifting concrete pit lids
- Installing pegs
- Taking photographs.

This work will be done during the day from 7am to 6pm **between Wednesday 27 August and Tuesday 30 September**, weather permitting.

There will be some noise associated with the work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses. Traffic will not be disrupted during this work.
