

## Night work on Soldiers Parade, Edmondson Park from Monday 25 November

The NSW Government is investing \$76 million to upgrade Campbelltown Road between Zouch Road and Ingleburn Gardens Drive, Bardia.



Roads and Maritime Services will carry out night work on Soldiers Parade, Edmondson Park over two night shifts between **Monday 25 November** and **Tuesday 3 December**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

Our work will include:

- excavation
- concreting and asphaltting
- saw cutting
- installing water mains.

These hours will be in addition to our normal work schedule of **Monday** to **Friday 7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday 8am** to **1pm**.

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for two night shifts between **Monday 25 November** and **Tuesday 3 December**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

These shifts are in addition to our normal work schedule of five shifts per week **Monday** to **Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**.
