# King Georges and Canterbury Road, Wiley Park

Start of works | November 2020

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading the intersection of King Georges Road and Canterbury Road at Wiley Park to reduce congestion and improve safety.

## Intersection upgrade

The intersection of King Georges Road and Canterbury Road currently operates at capacity during peak periods. Queues of vehicles can exceed the existing right turn bays, blocking through traffic.

The project will widen Canterbury Road to provide additional right turn lanes on to King Georges Road in both directions. This will improve traffic flow, reduce congestion and improve safety.



To ensure we protect public health and safety during the Coronavirus outbreak, we need to change the way we consult with the community. We will continue to respond to any questions or concerns you may have about our work.

## Our schedule

Transport for NSW will start work from 30 November 2020 and be completed by August 2022.

Our night work hours will be between 8pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday. Our day work hours are from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. We will not be working on public holidays.

- Stormwater works
- Kerb & gutter works
- Pavement works

- Landscaping

Our work will be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities by midnight.
