

Installation of new weekend and extended weekday clearways on Carlingford Road between Carlingford and Epping

Roads and Maritime Services | January 2018

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$121 million Clearways Program, which aims to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads.

Roads and Maritime Services is installing new weekend and extended weekday clearways on Carlingford Road from Pennant Hills Road, Carlingford to Beecroft Road, Epping, in January 2018. We have included a map to show the location of the new weekend and extended weekday clearways.

Extending the operating hours of existing clearways and installing new weekend clearways will help manage traffic flow and delays by restricting parking when warranted by traffic volumes. It will also allow us to tow vehicles that stop illegally or break down. This will ensure all lanes are available to traffic when the road is near capacity.

The new and extended clearways hours on Carlingford Road are shown below and on the map overleaf.

| | Current clearways | New and extended clearways |
|----------------------------|---------------------------|---|
| Weekdays | 6am to 10am 3pm to 7pm | 6am to 7pm (both directions) |
| Weekends & Public holidays | No clearways | 9am to 6pm (both directions) |

The existing parking restrictions on Carlingford Road will continue to operate outside these clearway times.

Changes to the clearways will be operational on Carlingford Road from **Monday 5 February 2018**. Any vehicles parked in the clearways on or after these dates would risk being fined and towed.

What is a clearway?

You must not stop or park on a length of road that is a clearway during its hours of operation. The drivers of public buses and taxis are permitted to stop when dropping off or picking up passengers. If your vehicle is parked in a clearway during its hours of operation, it will be towed, usually to a nearby street and fines will apply.

To report a vehicle parked in a clearway or if your vehicle has been towed from a clearway, please call Transport Management Centre on 131 700.

What happens next?

The new clearway signs and posts will be installed between **Monday 22 January 2018** and **Sunday 4 February 2018** weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Sunday**.

During the installation work, there will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **11pm**.

As a resident or visitor, what does this mean for me?

The new weekend and extended weekday clearways will change parking conditions in front of residential and business properties along Carlingford Road. We understand that this may cause some inconvenience to you.

If you currently live on this section of Carlingford Road, you will need to reconsider where you park during the new clearways hours. If you do not have a driveway, garage or carport on your property, local streets are available for you to park subject to council restrictions.

Outside the clearway hours, existing parking restrictions will remain in place. As clearways continue to be rolled out across Sydney, you, your family and friends will experience more efficient, safer and more reliable journey times. This means less time in the car and more time doing the things you enjoy.


