Continuing work on Carrington and Showground Roads at Castle Hill from 1 March

February 2022

The Australian and NSW Governments are taking action to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion and improving safety for all road users.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersections of Showground Road at Carrington Road and Showground Road at De Clambe Drive. We are also widening Showground and Carrington Roads to provide extra turning and bus lanes.

In the next three months, we will carry out the following works along the northern side of Showground Road and the western side of Carrington Road:

- continue removing various old utilities and cutting lines for new ones
- install new kerb, gutter and storm water drainage system
- rebuild footpath and pavement
- resurface and asphalt roads

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **75 day** and **58 night shifts** between **Tuesday 1 March** and **Tuesday 31 May**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from Monday to Friday and between **8am** and **1pm** on Saturday.

Night work will be carried out between **8pm** and **5am** from Sunday to Thursday the next day. We will work up to five nights per week.

We will not work on public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Where possible, our work will be carried out during the day. However, we will need to carry out some work at night to lessen the disruption to traffic and for the safety of our workers.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the southern side of Showground Road and the eastern side of Carrington Road.

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to reduce the disturbance, including completing noisier activities by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours for the widening works and for the work zone to be safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
