



Investigation work on Showground Road, Castle Hill from Wednesday 9 March

The NSW Government is upgrading Showground Road between Carrington Road and Old Northern Road, Castle Hill from a two lane to a four lane divided road.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out investigation work, which includes potholing.

This work will take **two** shifts to complete between **Wednesday 9 March** and **Thursday 10 March**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **8am** to **4pm**.

The work will be carried out along Showground Road, between Cheriton Avenue and Britannia Road.

We have included a map to help explain the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

There will be noise associated with this work, but we will make every effort to minimise its impact.

Access to properties in the work zone may be affected during shift hours. Work that takes place in front of properties will be of a temporary nature. Every effort will be made to not block any driveways and property access. In the unlikely case where a driveway is blocked when you require access, please speak to the person on site carrying out the work or contact Ross Daley on 0427 905 030. Every effort will be made to accommodate your requests.
