



Traffic changes and bus stop relocations night work on Showground Road, Castle Hill rescheduled to Tuesday 6 June

The NSW Government is funding a \$41 million upgrade to Showground Road, Castle Hill to reduce congestion and increase traffic capacity.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing to deliver this important project. The project will help to reduce congestion, increase traffic capacity to meet the predicted growth from development in the area and improve safety at several intersections.

To improve the safety for all road users, traffic changes and bus stop changes on Showground Road have been postponed until Tuesday 6 June

Roads and Maritime Services has postponed traffic changes on Showground Road until **Wednesday 7 June** to complete the pedestrian footpath on the eastbound side of Showground Road.

Traffic will be moved onto the westbound lanes of Showground Road between Carrington Road and Rowallan Avenue from **9pm** on **Wednesday 7 June**, weather permitting. This traffic arrangement will be in place until **September 2017**.

To prepare and complete the traffic changes, we will carry out **three shifts** of **night work** between **Tuesday 6 June** and **Thursday 8 June** from Carrington Road to Cheriton Avenue.

Concrete barriers along Showground Road will be extended from Carrington Road to Cheriton Avenue for the safety of motorists and workers. Parking restrictions will continue be in place with the closure of road shoulders along Showground Road.

During this work, Britannia Road will be temporarily closed at the intersection of Showground Road from **Tuesday 6 June** to **August 2017**, weather permitting. This will allow for the safe movement of motorists, pedestrians and workers as construction at the Britannia Avenue intersection continues. This temporary intersection closure will also allow us to limit the number of night work shifts in this area as work can be completed during day shifts.

Access for residents will be maintained at all times. If we need to restrict access, residents will be notified in advance.

Due to the postponed traffic changes, the changes two bus stops along Showground Road will also be postponed until **Tuesday 6 June**. The bus stop at Cheriton Avenue will be closed from **Tuesday 6 June** to the end of construction and the bus stop east of Cecil Avenue will be relocated 250 meters west of Cecil Avenue until the end of construction.

We have included a map to show the traffic changes and area of work.

How will the work affect you?

Work will continue to be carried out during standard construction hours from **Monday** to **Friday** between **7am** and **6pm** and **Saturday** between **7am** and **1pm**, excluding public holidays. However, a combination of day and night work is required to maintain safety and balance the impact to nearby residents and local motorists.

There may be some noise and lights associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise the impact by arranging the work in stages at different locations to allow opportunities for respite. Every effort will also be made to focus lights only on the working area and minimise spill-over of light into nearby residences.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place along Showground Road to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers and motorists. **A speed limit of 40km/h will continue to be in place**. Electronic message signs will advise road users about the traffic changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

The re-opening of the intersection of Showground Road and Cecil Avenue to through traffic has been delayed until September 2017. The presence of unknown utilities and coordination of external utility providers has caused some unforeseen construction delays. Work in this location is complex and requires the design and coordination of several utilities. We are currently working with external utility providers, to assess and carry out relocations without causing major disruption to the local community.
