

## Start of construction and night work on Showground Road, Castle Hill from Monday 4 July

**The NSW government is funding this \$41 million project to reduce congestion and increase traffic capacity to meet predicted growth in the area.**

Roads and Maritime Services will be starting major construction of Showground Road, between Carrington Road and Old Northern Road, Castle Hill from Monday 4 July.

The work includes:

- Clearing vegetation
- Relocating utilities in stages along Showground Road, between Carrington Road and Kentwell Avenue. The work will start from the Carrington Road end
- Adjusting driveways on private properties to meet the new road level.

This work will be carried out from **Monday 4 July** until **late September 2016**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be **7am to 6pm, Mondays to Fridays**.

### Night work

There will be up to **five night shifts** per week from **Monday 4 July** until **late September 2016**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be **8pm to 5am, Mondays to Fridays**.

The work will include installing new utilities and drainage across Showground Road and survey work to clearly identify property boundaries.

A combination of day and night work is required to be carried out to maintain safety and balance the impact to nearby residents and motorists.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be some disruptions associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise obstructions to driveways and noise by arranging the work for up to five nights in one location and then moving the to a new location along Showground Road to allow opportunities for respite for residents and businesses.

Every effort will be made to focus the light only on the working area, however there is likely to be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

### Traffic changes

During this work, the following traffic changes will be in place:

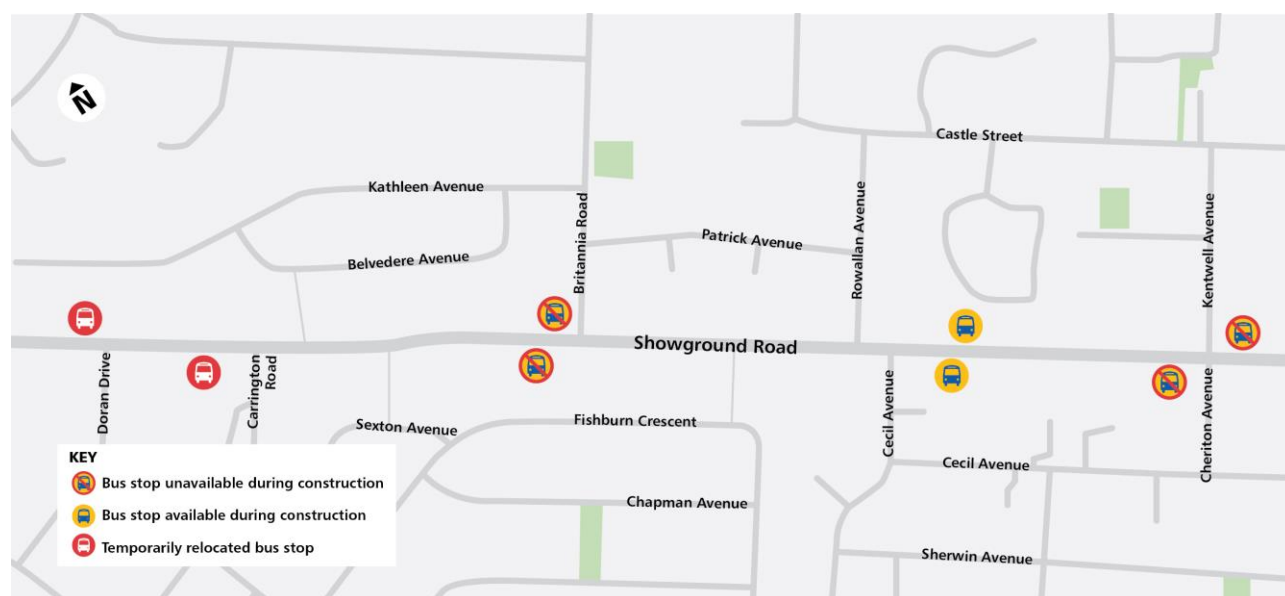
- One westbound lane of Showground Road, between Britannia Road and Carrington Road, will be closed reducing the lanes to one lane in each direction. This lane closure will be in place from Monday 4 July, 24 hours a day, seven days a week until late November 2016
- Parking along the shoulder of Showground Road will not be permitted from Monday 25 July throughout construction to allow for road pavement and drainage work
- The speed will be reduced to 40km/hr through the construction zone, 24 hours a day, seven days a week and traffic control and signage will be in place
- Access at Britannia Road will be permanently changed to left in, left out traffic only from Monday 4 July.

There will be delays along Showground Road due to the changed traffic conditions. Motorists are asked to allow extra time to travel. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. ## Changes to bus stops

To minimise delays to bus services and ensure the safety of bus customers, some bus stops along Showground Road will be temporarily unavailable during construction. We have included a map to help explain the changes. Bus stops will be relocated as construction progresses, starting from Monday 18 July. New bus stop locations will be clearly signposted. We have included a map to explain these relocations.
