

Investigation work at Tumbi Road and Central Coast Highway intersection, Wamberal from Tuesday 9 March

The NSW Government is investing in planning to improve traffic flow and safety by upgrading the Central Coast Highway for 4.8 kilometres between Wamberal and Bateau Bay.

As part of the project, the upgrade of the Tumbi Road and Central Coast Highway has been fast tracked with planning now being carried out.

Transport for NSW will carry out work including geotechnical investigations at sites around the Tumbi Road intersection to better understand the ground conditions. We have included a map below to show the work zone.

These field investigations will help to prepare the detailed design for the proposed intersection upgrade.

Work will be split between day and night shifts. The day shifts will be carried out between **7am** and **5pm** and the night shifts **between 7pm and 5am** from **Tuesday 9 March**. We expect to complete the work in **four weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during night work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow a couple of minutes extra travel time during this work.
