## Night work on Cessnock Road, Testers Hollow upgrade from Monday 17 January

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this \$17 million project to upgrade Cessnock Road at Testers Hollow to reduce the impact of flooding and improve connectivity.

Transport for NSW and construction partner Daracon Contractors started construction in November 2020.

Normal work hours are between 7am and 6pm on weekdays and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays. Some out of hours work is required for the safety of motorists and workers.

Night work will be carried out between **6pm** and **5am** from **Monday 17 January** to **Friday 21 January**, weather permitting. No night work will be carried out on Saturday or Sunday.

During the night work we will be trenching and drilling along Cessnock Road for the relocation of utility services.

### How will the work affect you?

There is expected to be some minor noise impacts during the night. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and completing noisier work before midnight.

We will continue to keep the community informed about upcoming work as the project progresses.

### Traffic changes

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during the work and this may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.
