Early work for Cessnock Road, Testers Hollow upgrade from Monday 12 October

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this \$17 million project to upgrade Cessnock Road at Testers Hollow to reduce the impact of flooding and improve connectivity.

Transport for NSW has recently awarded the contract to Daracon to build the new, two lane road that will be 1.5 metres higher than the existing road.

We will be establishing a site office and compound on Cessnock Road at the southern end of the project from **Monday 12 October** in preparation for the project commencing. We will use the compound for our site offices, to store materials and to access the project. We have included a map to show the location of the site office and compound. We will also be installing safety barriers and carrying out road surveying activities on Cessnock Road at Testers Hollow for one night on Monday 12 October.

How will the work affect you?

We will be working between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am and 1pm** on **Saturday**.

We will continue to keep the community informed about upcoming work as the project progresses.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.


