





The Chandos Street Noise Wall will help reduce traffic noise for nearby residents between St Thomas' Rest Park and Brook Street, Crows Nest.

It is likely you have recently noticed some changes going on in your local community for the construction of the Chandos Street Noise Wall. This includes the establishment of our site compound on the Warringah Freeway, work at the end of Chandos Street and temporary traffic and pedestrian changes.

We thank you for your patience during this time. We will continue to write to you every three months to provide an update on our work.

### What work will be carried out?

Between **Saturday 1 February** and **Sunday 3 May 2020** we will be carrying out work from St
Thomas' Rest Park to Jenkins Lane including
continuing the removal of vegetation,
excavating and building footings, and installing
noise wall posts.

#### Our work schedule

We will be working through the day and up to 15 nights over the next three months, to build the noise wall as quickly as possible.

We will carry out our work between:

- 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am and 1pm Saturdays, and
- 8pm and 5am Sunday to Friday.

No work will carried out on public holidays.

It is difficult for us to confirm the exact nights we will be working during this period because of the weather and the approvals we need to be able to work on the road.
