Cremorne Point stair work

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out work on the stairs connecting Milson Road and Cremorne Reserve between Monday 3 and Friday 7 July 2017, weather permitting.

Work was carried out in 2016 replacing the old stairs to improve access and safety. Having reviewed the new stairs in operation some additional work has been identified that would reduce future maintenance and increase longevity of the structures.

Work will include changes to the stair surfaces and handrail. To ensure pedestrian safety during the work, the stairs will be closed between Monday 3 and Friday 7 July, weather permitting. Work will be carried out during standard construction hours between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience during the closure of the stairs.

Access during the upgrade:

- the stairs will be closed but pedestrians will be able to access the foreshore by the footpath connecting to Milson Road
- two accessible parking bays located within the construction area will be closed and a temporary accessible parking space will be provided near the Cremorne Point Wharf
- all other existing parking spaces on Milson Road will remain unchanged
- access to the wharf, café and the adjacent Sydney Water Pumping Station will be maintained.
