

Intersection upgrade on the Cumberland Highway and The Horsley Drive, Smithfield

Completion of work

Transport for NSW has completed road improvements to extend the southbound left-turn bay on the Cumberland Highway to The Horsley Drive, Smithfield.

These improvements have extended the southbound left-turn bay on the Cumberland Highway to The Horsley Drive eastbound lane by about 30 metres.

Transport has successfully carried out this work as part of the Urban Road Congestion Program to improve safety for road users. The road improvements to the intersection will ease congestion, reduce traffic delays, improve safety and travel time for drivers in Smithfield and the greater Fairfield City area.

The final stage of the upgrade is now complete.

What did we do?

Our work included:

- extending the left-turn bay on the Cumberland Highway southbound to The Horsley Drive by about 30 metres
- footpath works on Cumberland Highway to make room for the extended left-turn bay
- installing new turf and restoring the compound area

Key benefits:

- reduce congestion from the Cumberland Highway to The Horsley Drive
- improve traffic flow southbound on Cumberland Highway
- improve safety for road users
