

Traffic changes and night work on Dawson River Bridge, Manning River Drive, Cundletown from Monday 14 November

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance to preserve the structural integrity of Dawson River Bridge and to reduce future maintenance costs.

Transport for NSW and construction partner RMP Abrasive Blasting are continuing the final stage of work which includes painting the bridge and steel and concrete repairs as part of a painting and maintenance project.

Transport for NSW started work on Dawson River Bridge in late April 2021. Due to continuing weather impacts we have experienced delays to the completion of the project. Work is expected to be complete in **early 2023, weather permitting**.

We will be continuing work to complete steel repairs, prepare the steel surface for painting and install and wrap scaffolding as we work progressively along the bridge.

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Saturdays**.

To minimise the impact to motorists, and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, some steel repair work will be carried out at night from **Monday 21 November**. Night work will be completed between **7pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Thursday**. We expect night work to be complete in **one week**, weather permitting.

There will be no work during the holiday period from **Friday 23 December 2022** to **Sunday 8 January 2023**.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. We have included a map to show the work location.

How will the work affect you?

The work involves the use of machinery which will generate some noise and light. We will make every effort to minimise noise and light by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Dawson River Bridge will be reduced to a single lane between **9am** and **3pm** from **Monday** to **Saturday**. Electronic message boards will be in place to advise motorists of traffic changes.

While there will be no bridge closures, short stoppages may be required and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours, which will affect travel times.

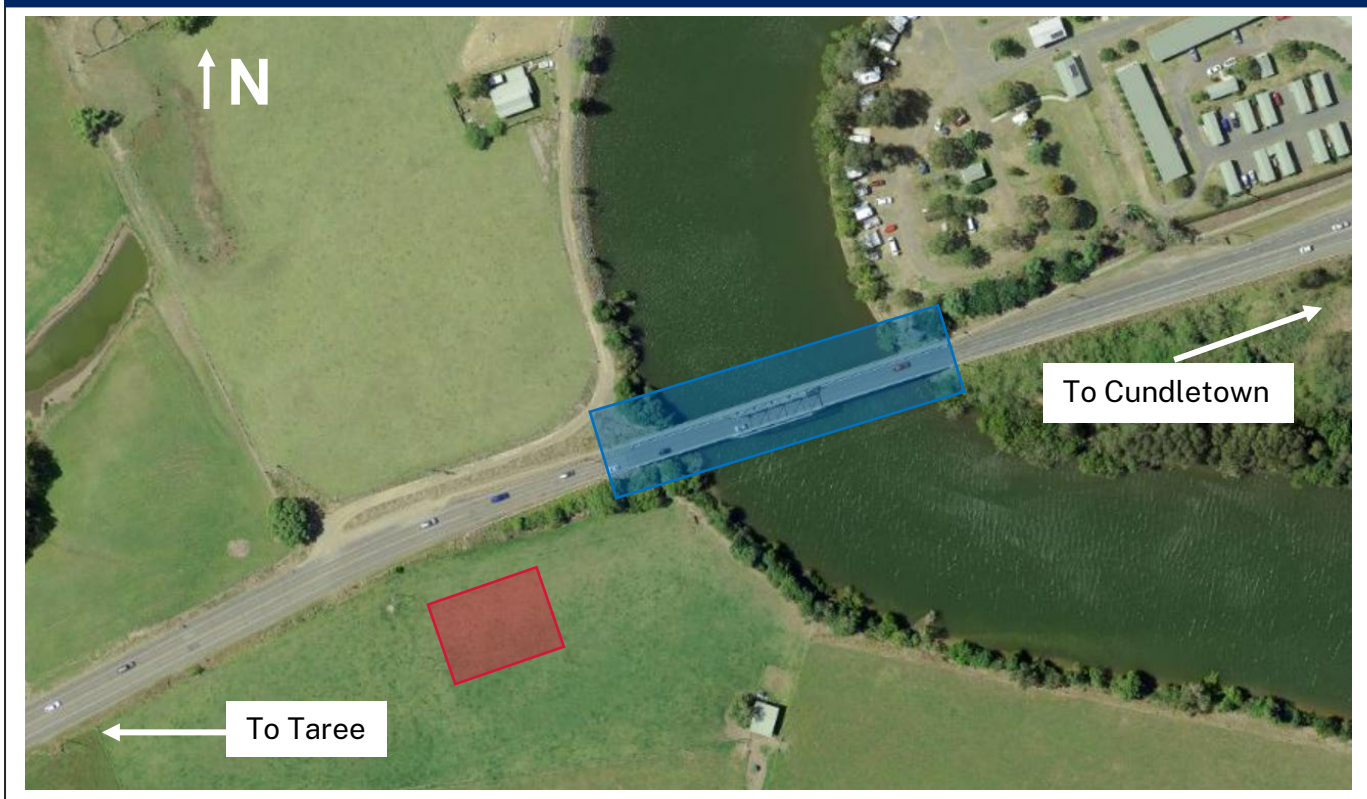
