

Final stage of work on Dawson River Bridge, Manning River Drive, Cundletown from Monday 31 January

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance to preserve the structural integrity of Dawson River Bridge and to reduce future maintenance costs.

Transport for NSW started maintenance on Dawson River Bridge in late April 2021, as part of the painting and maintenance project. Stage one and two are now complete, with the final stage of work due to start from **Monday 31 January 2022**.

Transport for NSW and construction partner RMP Abrasive Blasting will carry out the final stage of work, which includes painting the bridge, steel and concrete repairs.

Work will be carried out during the day between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Saturday** and is expected to be completed in **8 months**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work involves the use of machinery which will generate some noise and light. We will make every effort to minimise noise and light by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Occasional lane closures, stop/slow traffic arrangements and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place and may affect travel times. There will be no bridge closures or detours during or outside work hours.
