Work continues on Devlin Street, Ryde

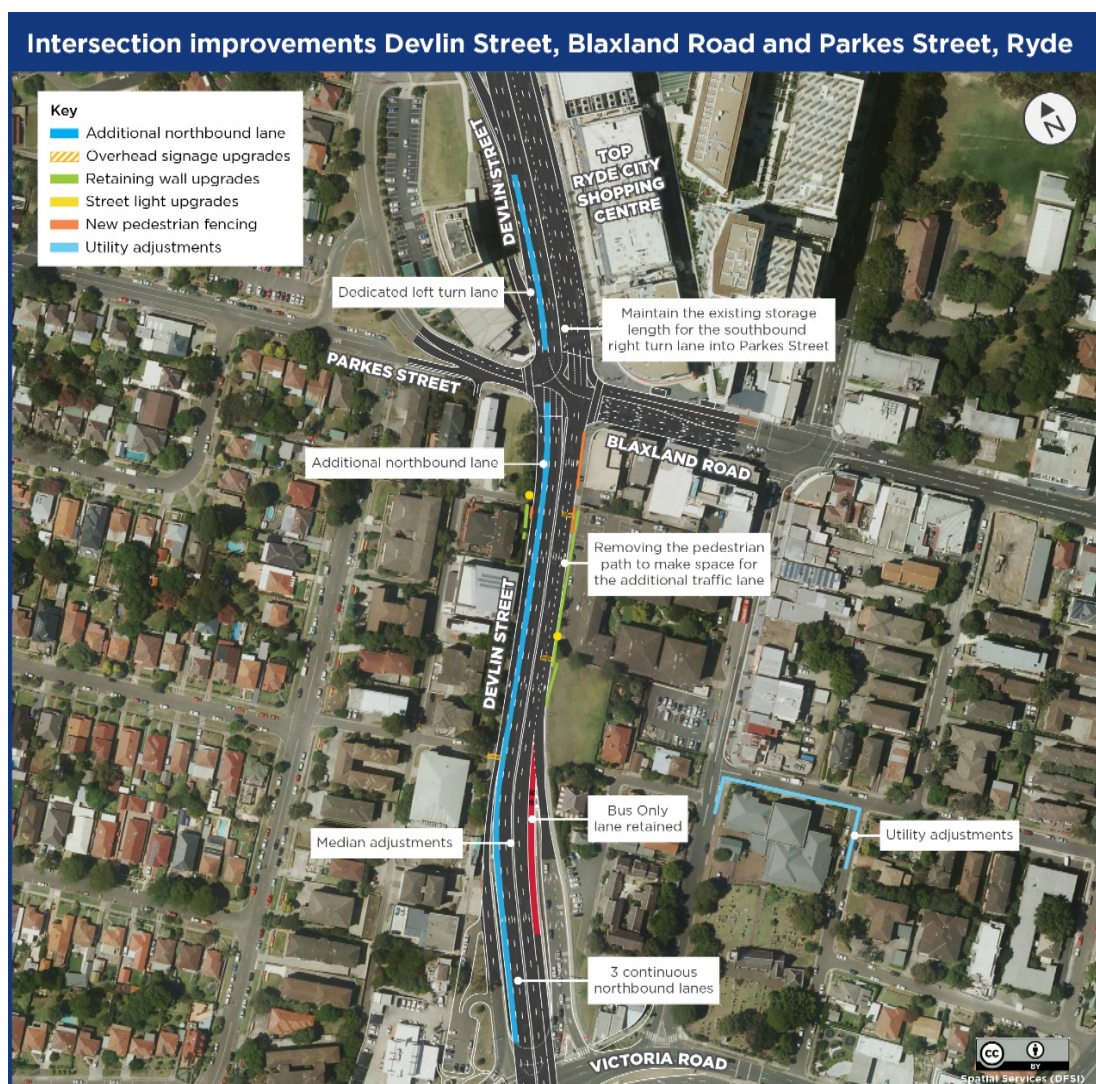
The Australian and NSW Governments are taking action to improve Sydney's road network, easing congestion and improving traffic flow, travel times and road safety.

We are adding a fourth northbound lane on Devlin Street between Victoria Road and Blaxland Road, improving traffic flow through the intersection.

Recent work

In the past three months on Devlin Street we have:

- installed 56 metres of stormwater drains under the median
- started building the fourth northbound lane
- constructed the new northbound footpath
- built a temporary median north of Blaxland Road.



What's happening next?

Between **Monday 18 October** and **Friday 4 February** along Devlin Street we will:

- complete installation of two overhead signs
- install two new street lights
- transfer the electrical supply to the newly installed cables
- continue to build the new median and northbound lane
- construct the new southbound footpath, kerb, gutter, trench drain and road pavement
- remove the old road surface and lay the new road resurface and line mark.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **30 day and 67 night shifts** between **Monday 18 October** and **Friday 4 February**, weather permitting. There will be no work on public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from Monday to Friday and **8am** to **1pm** on Saturdays. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from Sunday to Friday.

We will work a maximum of 5 nights per week.

How will the work affect you?

Our night work may be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to lessen the disruption to residents, including staging the work in different locations along the work zone and completing the noisier activities by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes on Devlin Street during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller's directions.
