

## Investigation work is continuing at various locations in Dubbo as part of the New Dubbo Bridge project from Wednesday 29 September



From **Wednesday 29 September**, Transport for NSW will carry out additional heritage survey inspections in a number of locations as part of the New Dubbo Bridge project. The Review of Environmental Factors for the project was determined in December 2019. To enable the detailed design to be finalised additional areas have been identified which require inspection prior to construction. The map above shows the location of these works.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday**. We expect to complete the work in **3 days**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

## How will the work affect you?

Access to your property will be required to undertake the work. We will let you know at least 24 hours before access is required.

Work crews will be adhering to strict Covid-19 protocols with approved Covid-19 safety plans in place and NSW Health work permits. The program of work is subject to change in response to any further government restrictions that may be put in place to manage Covid-19.
