



Construction update

Herring Road Improvements Macquarie Park

August 2022

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in Macquarie Park to improve public transport and the road network.

Saturday night work 3 September

On **Saturday 3 September** between **8pm** and **8am** we will be working at the Epping Road and Herring Road intersection. This work needs to be done on a Saturday night to avoid traffic disruption as we make changes to the old lane configuration. Activities such as saw-cutting will stop at midnight. Other works such as the use of small hand tools will continue until 8am.

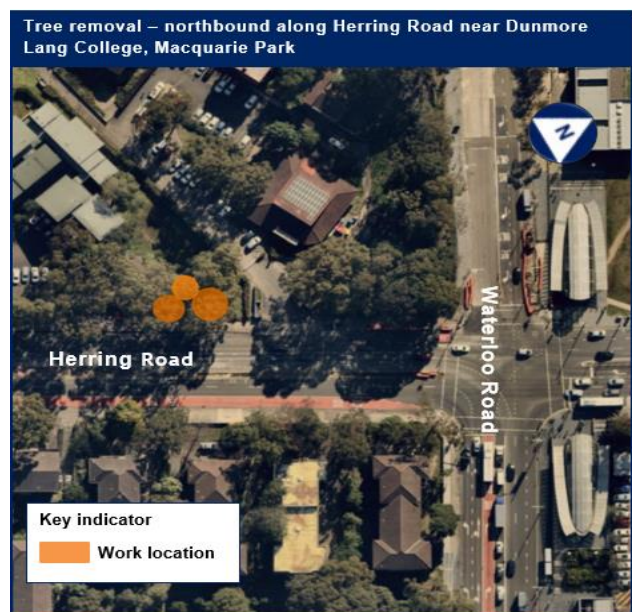
We will not be working at night on **Thursday 1 September** or **Thursday 8 September** at the Epping Road and Herring Road intersection and northbound towards Windsor Drive to ensure we give the community a break from our work.

If this work is cancelled due to wet weather, it will be rescheduled to **Saturday 10 September** with no works on **Thursday 8 September** and **Thursday 15 September**.

Tree removal and replacement

Sunday 4 September we will work over up to four night shifts between **8pm** and **5am** to remove three trees in front of Dunmore Lang College, Macquarie Park. This work will require the use of a chainsaw and will be noisy, at times.

We have worked with our tree specialist to try to keep these trees, however their root system is within the new footpath work zone. Transport will replace each removed tree and is working with City of Ryde Council to identify potential locations for plantings within the local area.



Road resurfacing

From **Sunday, 11 September** we will be working to resurface the widened Herring Road between Epping Road and Waterloo Road.

How will the road resurfacing work affect you?

Road resurfacing can be loud as we use equipment like profilers, which grind away at the old road surface. This work will restrict night-time driveway access for some properties. We will notify residents at these properties with specific dates and times.

We will do everything we can to reduce noise, including:

- complete noisier work earlier in the shift
- using noise blankets around equipment where possible
- selecting less noisy equipment
- switching off equipment when not in use
- directing our lights away from residential properties near our work zone
- monitoring our construction noise levels.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
