



Work continues on the Macquarie Park Bus Priority Improvements – Epping Road and Herring Road

Transport for NSW| April 2021

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in Macquarie Park to improve public transport and the road network.

Transport for NSW will continue work to provide a dedicated northbound bus lane on Herring Road between Epping Road and Waterloo Road. Our improvements also include upgrades to three intersections along this section of Herring Road.

Our work will support Macquarie Park's growth, ensuring we can meet the area's future transport needs. We aim to complete this project in late 2022.



What is happening next?

Over the next few months, on Herring Road we will:

- install a temporary roundabout and median at the Ivanhoe Place intersection while we construct the new lanes and install traffic lights
- widen the southbound lane and build a new kerb near the Ivanhoe Place intersection to make space for the extended bus lane
- install additional stormwater drains between Ivanhoe Place and Waterloo Road
- install a temporary median between Windsor Drive and Waterloo Road
- continue gas, water, telecommunications and electricity relocations.

Our work schedule

We carry out most of our work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers, pedestrians and road users.

During our upcoming work between **Sunday 18 April** and **Friday 9 July**, we will be on site for **58 night shifts** and **20 day shifts**.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturday**. We will not work on public holidays.

How will the work affect me?

We will make every effort to minimise noise and disruption. We will complete noisier tasks by **midnight**. Where possible, we will use noise blankets, direct noise-generating equipment and lights away from properties and turn vehicles and machinery off when not in use.

Traffic changes

A temporary footpath will be in place on part of Herring Road to safely detour pedestrians away from our work zone.

There will also be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. This will include lane closures which may affect travel times. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
