Changes to our work hours from Monday 2 August 2021

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in Macquarie Park to improve public transport and the road network.

In line with recent restrictions introduced by the NSW Government to help keep our communities safe, construction activities on the Herring Road improvements are paused until after Friday 30 July 2021.

We are making arrangements to safely restart our work activities from 31 July 2021. Should these restrictions change based on advice by the NSW Government, which may impact the timing of our work, the community will be notified. We encourage you to visit our website at nswroads.work/macpark to stay up to date with our work activities.

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. You may see some of our workers on site as they prepare the sites for work. Please be assured our people and worksites follow NSW Health's COVID-19 requirements and will continue to do so.

Our work schedule is temporarily changing

Transport for NSW is widening Herring Road between Epping Road and Waterloo Road to provide a dedicated northbound bus lane. We are also upgrading three intersections along Herring Road at Epping Road, Ivanhoe Place and Waterloo Road.

We understand our work through the night can be noisy and disruptive. We need to carry out this important work at night, to reduce the disruption to the road network and for the safety of workers and road users.

We want to let you know we've heard you and listened. From **Monday 2 August** we will adjust our work schedule to carry out some of our noisier activity during the day.

With current stay-at-home orders in place and less movement on the roads, we will temporarily adjust our work schedule to carry out some of our noisy activity during the day to reduce the disturbance of our work on the community.

Day work

We will work Monday to Friday between **7am** and **5pm**. We have planned to do most of the noisier work like saw cutting and jackhammering during the day.

We are aware residents are working from home and will do everything we can to limit the disturbance. Where possible, we will use noise blankets, direct noise-generating equipment away from properties and turn vehicles and machinery off when not in use.

Night work

At the Ivanhoe Place and Herring Road intersection, we will work **night shifts** between **Sunday 15 August** and **Thursday 19 August**.

At the Herring Road and Epping Road intersection, the roads are still too busy to conduct our work during the day safely so we can only work nights at this location. We will continue to work **five night shifts a week** from Sunday and Thursday.

Our night work hours are between **8pm** and **5am**, finishing noisier activity at **midnight**.



How long will the new work schedule changes last?

The new temporary work schedule allows us to work on the road during the day, which has only been made possible during the evolving Coronavirus situation during the current stay-at-home orders. At this stage, it is estimated this will continue through until Monday 30 August 2021.
