



Start of work - Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road Intersection, Macquarie Park

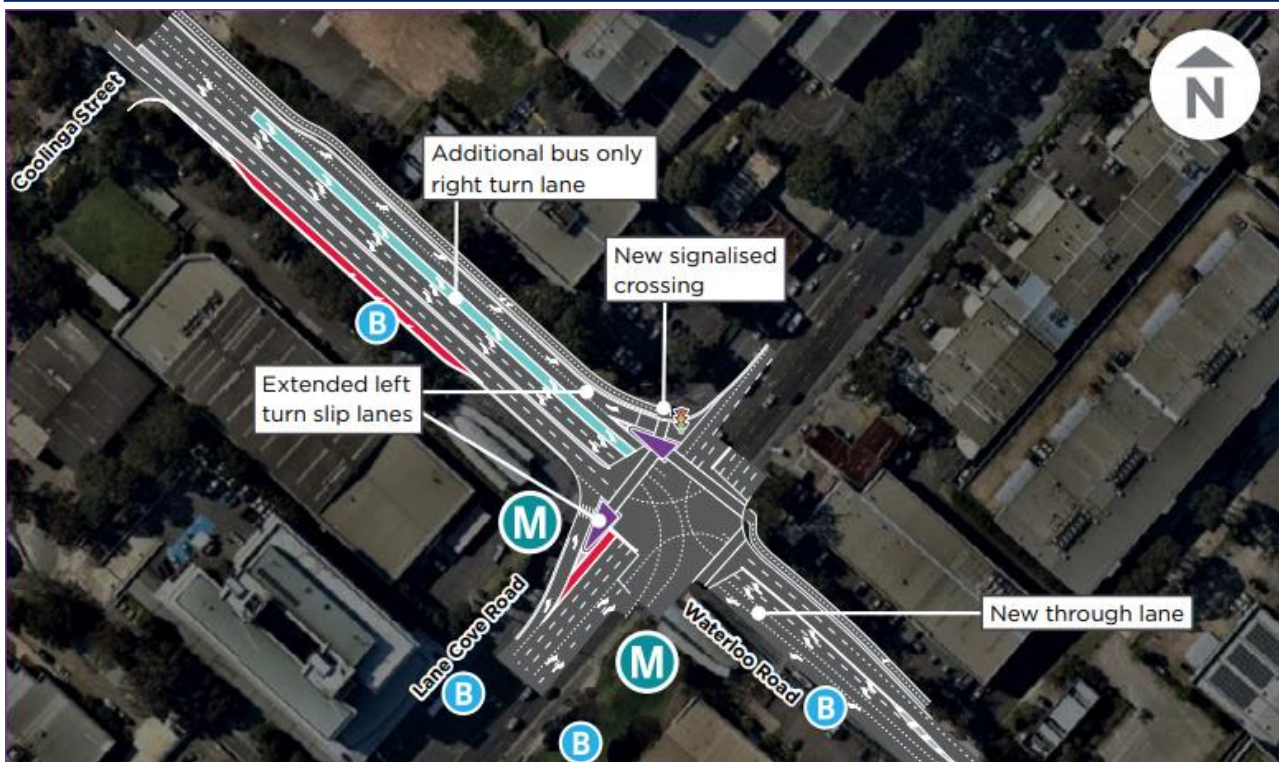
The Australian Government and NSW Government are upgrading the intersection as part of a \$240 million investment to support economic growth and create jobs, getting Australians back to work sooner following the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Transport for NSW is starting work on the intersection of Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road at Macquarie Park to improve bus travel through the intersection, reduce congestion and improve travel times. We expect to complete this project in early 2024.

The intersection upgrade will:

- provide a 170m dedicated bus only right turn lane from Waterloo Road onto Lane Cove south
- provide a 70m westbound through lane to Waterloo Road
- extend the northbound left hand turn slip lane from Lane Cove Road onto Waterloo Road
- extend the left turn lane from Waterloo Road eastbound onto Lane Cove Road.

Our upcoming work

We recently set up our site compound at 27 Waterloo Road, Macquarie Park. Our workers will use this site to store equipment and materials for the work.

Our upcoming work will include:

- inspecting the existing drainage
- clearing of vegetation
- drilling the pavement
- property adjustment works
- finding underground services like telecommunications, water, sewer and electricity

Our work schedule

We will work both day and night shifts to complete the work safely and keep traffic flowing.

Our day work hours will be from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturday**.

If we do night work, our hours will be between **Sunday and Thursday**, from **8pm to 5am** the next day.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to lessen the effects of construction on the community where possible. Our work may be noisy at times, but we will put in place measures to reduce the disturbance to surrounding businesses and residents, such as turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers, and completing the noisier tasks before midnight.

Traffic changes

Temporary lane closures and footpath detours will be in place at times at the intersection of Waterloo Road and Lane Cove Road.

Traffic controllers and signs will be in place to help guide pedestrians and motorists through the area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Travel times may be affected, so we thank you in advance for your patience during this important work.
