Investigation work on Herring Road, for the Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange

October 2022

The Australian Government and NSW Government are investing nearly \$200 million to improve public transport in Macquarie Park and help create a vibrant 'heart' for the precinct.



The Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange REF (Review of Environmental Factors) closed for comment on 8 September. We want to thank those community members who took the time to comment on the REF. These submissions are currently being recorded in the Submissions Report, when complete it will be made available on the project webpage. Transport for NSW will begin investigation work along Herring Road, Waterloo Road and Talavera Road to help inform the detailed design, which is the next stage of the project after the submissions report is released. These investigative works will include surveying above ground and potholing below ground to identify utilities. Pavement and geotechnical investigation activities along Herring Road will also occur. This work will be carried out between 22 October 2022 and 20 January 2023.

How will the work affect you?

The investigation activities will take place on the footpath, road and within Macquarie Centre carpark. Some of our investigation work will occur during the day, however, we will need to carry out most of this work at night to reduce the disruption to traffic and to ensure the safety of workers.

Our night work may be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance, including staging the work in different locations and completing the noisier activities by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and footpath detours will be in place at times, which may affect travel times.

Traffic controllers and signs will be in place to help guide pedestrians and motorists through the area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for 15 day and 25 night shifts, between Saturday 22 October 2022 and Friday 20 January 2023, weather permitting, excluding public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and from **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.
